Show and Scheduling Information

Rock the Block: A Walk & Roll Musical (Elementary Schools)

Bay Area Children's Theatre has partnered with the Alameda County Safe Routes to Schools program to create Rock the Block: A Walk and Roll Musical for elementary school students. The show features singing, dancing, comedy, and lessons about safely walking and bicycling to and from school.

Recommended for Pre-K through 5th Grade

Step Up (Middle Schools)

A high-energy interactive show that is part rock concert, part game show. The show discusses safety skills necessary for students to independently navigate by walking, biking, or taking transit. It also starts to introduce concepts students will have to face as they begin driving with older students who are new drivers such as texting while driving and drunk driving.

Recommended for Grades 4 and up

Scheduling Information

- Run time for both shows is approximately 40 minutes
- There is no ideal time to schedule an assembly, but we generally do not schedule shows more than an hour apart. ex: 8:30a & 9:15a OR 9:00a & 10:00a
- We try to keep each assembly to no more than 250 students. We perform a maximum of two shows per day, so if you have more than 500 students at your school, we are happy to come back and do a third and/or fourth assembly on a second day.
- Space needs:
 - at least 15' x 15' floor space or stage space
 - at least one electrical outlet for sound system
 - We bring everything else you need!
- Need access to school site 60 minutes before first show to set-up
- Need 30 minutes after the show to breakdown
- It is possible and encouraged to do back-to-back to shows at one school
- Different actors are in both shows so it is only possible to book one show per day at one school
